**M**ichael Josef Hall, age 20 of Muskegon, MI, met his Heavenly Father face-to-face on Sunday afternoon, July 27, 2025. After a long and courageous battle with depression, his pain simply became unbearable. He was the beloved son of Jeff and Heather, and a dear brother to Johnathan and Natalie.

Michael brought a smile to the faces of all who met him, and he cared with every fiber of his being. He was tender-hearted and filled with compassion everywhere he went. He was not afraid to try new adventures, whether that was majoring in the up-and-coming world of e-sports broadcast and production at Ferris State University, learning to change tires at Sam's Club, serving ice-cream at the Lunch Box, or his latest venture of serving as an employee at Cedar Point through His House Ministries.

Michael was a life-long member of the Mona Shores community, graduating with the class of 2023. During his time as a student at Mona Shores, he impacted the lives of both students and staff through his kindness, intellect, and sense of humor. As a senior, he found the world of e-sports, and his life was forever changed. As much as he loved playing video games, his passion was working behind the scenes through the livestreaming production of various tournaments and events, as well as creating his own YouTube streaming channel. He was able to use those skills and experiences to minister as an audio-visual technician at his church, Forest Park Covenant Church, serving as one of the lead soundboard operators in the sanctuary.

He also had a passion for all things Star Wars, designing his own original light saber, building intricate Lego displays, and being the master of Star Wars trivia in his family. Michael would serve as the tour guide in the Star Wars section at Disney World, and point out the smallest details in every Star Wars film. In addition, Michael could solve any problem involving technology; and if he didn't have the answer, he was determined to find it. He even built his own PC to use for his

streaming and academic work before he went to college.

Michael always loved Jesus, always had a desire to serve Jesus; but it was only in the last two years at Ferris State University that he truly made his faith his own. He found the Jesus he had been looking for all his life when he became involved in His House Ministries. This group of students and adult leaders embraced Michael right where he was, pondering his deep questions and encouraging him to seek answers for himself. In March of 2025, while on a mission trip to Virginia, he dedicated his life to the Lord and was baptized. It was after that trip that Michael fell in love with Jesus and desired to serve Him with his whole life.

Over time, some of those questions became very deep for Michael, causing an inner turmoil that, combined with his life-long battle with depression, made his thoughts overwhelming. Even after reaching out and receiving help, searching the Scriptures, and praying with all his being, he became convinced that Heaven was the only place he would find exactly what he was looking for, and we believe he did.

Michael is preceded in death by his grandparents, John and Rosemary Swinburne. He is survived by his loving parents, Jeff and Heather, his brother Johnathan and his sister Natalie. He was the precious grandson of Tim and Kathy (Anderson) Hall. He is also survived by a number of aunts and uncles who adored him, including Lynne (John) McLaughlin, Kim (Jay) Mundinger, Julianne (Scott) Priolo, Sarah (Travis) Ault, Shannon (Michael) Faust, Carrie (Michael) Lukasek, Scott (Alicia) Swinburne, David Swinburne, and Mike and Ginny Henry. In addition, he leaves behind 24 cousins who will miss him deeply.
