Leon preceded Margaret in death May 5, 1990 and Sandi Gillings their eldest daughter on June 21, 2009 and recently son in law Doug DeHaan Dec. 31, 2015. Margaret and Leon were the former owners of the Colonial Kitchen Restaurant in Grand Haven. Margaret was an active member of the United Methodist Church of the Dunes in Grand Haven and was very well known for her cooking for luncheons, dinners, the Kiwanis organization and was well known for her cinnamon rolls that she often made for the church bazaars which were gone within the first hour. Margaret enjoyed sewing, camping, bowling, walking and riding her bike because she never drove a car. Family was very important to her and she was always there for her three daughters even if it meant giving up something she was doing for herself. Margaret worked at the Christian Haven Home in Grand Haven as the Head Cook for more than 35 years and at 83 she was still working one or two days a week. Finally in 2009 she retired from the Home.
