Martin Frederick Levandoski passed away peacefully at home, at the age of 94, on May 24, 2025. He was born on October 7, 1930, in Grand Rapids, Michigan to Fred and Lillian Levandoski.

Marty married the love of his life, Garnet Hoover, on July 28, 1951, in San Antonio, Texas. They were married for 70 years and had three children Roxanna, John and Robin.

Marty enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1951. During his career in the Air Force, he and Garnet traveled the world. They were stationed in Germany, Illinois, France, Washington State, Alaska and Colorado. His Air Force career spanned twenty years. His last year was spent at Tan Son Nhut Air Base just outside Saigon, Vietnam.
